Will you join us on this journey from Gimuy (Cairns), Ngurapai (Horn Island), Waiben (Thursday Island), Kerriri (Hammond Island) over and through the lands, seas, skies and waterways of the First Peoples of Far North Queensland?

Learning Intentions

- Experience cultural practices that provide context for place and millennia old cultural ways of being, knowing, doing and valuing (singing, dancing, story, site markers)
- Participate in and be witness to Catholic and Ecumenical services
- Deeply listen to elders about lore and explore the impact of contact on maintaining culture
- Engage in opportunities for personal and professional reflection including conversation circles, listening books and professional reading pertaining to Encounter In Country Experiences
